

A TOUCH of the WILD

Birthday Party

Thank you for joining us on this special Birthday Party. We hope everyone has a fantastic day.

Our secret woodland camp address:

Our address is Grammarcombe Woods, Ashcombe Estate, Ashcombe, Devon EX7 0QE (nearest postcode). Directions can be found below and we are signposted from Ashcombe roundabout. A map can be found on our website. Please make your way into camp to meet your leader, it's just beyond the car park, 50 yds down the track into the woods.

You will be asked to complete a consent form when you arrive and give your emergency contact number and detail of any allergies or requirements your child might have. Please make sure someone else can do this on your behalf if you are not bringing your child to the party.

Directions: From Exeter, follow the M5 west and stay on the road as it becomes the A38. At Telegraph Hill, take the left fork road A380 signed to Torquay. Follow the road for about 3 miles and take the left exit signed Teignmouth (B3192). At roundabout turn left signed Ashcombe, follow the road around the bend, in about 500 yards you will see A Touch of the Wild signs at the double gateway on your left.

From Newton Abbot/Torquay, on the A380 towards Exeter, take signs for Ashcombe, Chudleigh. Down slip road take signs for B3192. Go over bridge across dual carriageway. At roundabout go straight over, towards Ashcombe. Follow the road around the bend and in about 500 yards you will see A Touch of the Wild signs at the double gateway on your left.

Parking: There is enough space for over 100 cars, and parking is free.

Late arrivals & Weekend Contact:

The office is closed at weekends so if you are running late or unable to make it on the day, please contact the Birthday boy or girl's parents direct to let them know as the office phone will not be answered over the weekend.

Toilet facilities: We have a compost toilet to use at our camp in the woods, but it would be worth making sure they use the WC before they arrive where possible.

Kit list: Your child will need to come dressed for a fun and muddy day outdoors in the woods. You might like to check the weather forecast beforehand in order to ensure that your child is appropriately dressed.

May – October: Sun hat, suncream (already applied), covered toe shoes/boots, long trousers.

October – May: Warm layers, waterproof (insulated) coat, waterproof trousers, 2 pairs of WARM socks, spare WARM jumper/fleece, wellington boots, hat, gloves, scarf if very cold.

Please be aware that it is always more cold and draughty in the woods, since we are under the cover of trees. Your children being comfortable and warm will make such a difference to their experience.

Queries: If you have any questions about the day, please contact the Birthday Party organiser/parent or call the office on 07929 613 284. **Please note however that the office is closed over the weekend when most parties take place.**

Safety: Please note that our camp is a no smoking area. Please make sure your child doesn't bring a pen knife or any similar sharp tools.

Important Information for the party organizer only: Please make sure that all invitees are given a copy of this document so that they know what to bring and where to meet. We will email you at least a week before the party with the contact number of your Party Leader – do contact us at least 4 days before your party if you haven't received this. We will ask parents to fill in a consent form (giving emergency contact number and any allergies or special requirements) when they arrive at camp. Please make sure there is someone able to fill this in on behalf of every child attending the party.
